



## The Church of Scotland

The Church of Scotland is seeking a consultant to advise on the installation of audio visual equipment at its properties to ensure that schemes are fit for purpose and offer value for money, while taking into account the architectural character of the building.

The consultant will work predominantly with [The Committee of Art & Architecture](#) (CARTA) but may also be asked to advise the General Trustees or Law Department, particularly in relation to dispute resolution.

The fee available is £15,000 per annum paid monthly in arrears.

Expressions of interest must be sent to [fskellett@churchofscotland.org.uk](mailto:fskellett@churchofscotland.org.uk) by 5pm on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> February, and should include a C.V with covering letter and written response (approx. 500 words) to the following question:

- **What key issues would you explore with a congregation before designing an installation to meet their needs?**

Shortlisted candidates will be invited to present their proposals on 7<sup>th</sup> March 2019. This will include a 10 minute presentation that will be defined in the invitation to interview.

This is a pilot project and will be reviewed after 12 months.
